

## **PROGRAM**

**LAST WEEK:** Denise James, is the Executive Director for Habitat for Humanity in Southern Oregon. It has been in existence in the Rogue Valley since 1987. It has completed and sold 62 homes and completed 61 small projects and 9 critical home projects for low income home owners. The overall organization was started in 1976. Incidentally, it was not started by Jimmy Carter. He just was high profile person that got really involved. It now exists in 60 countries and has 1,000 affiliates in the U.S. The families purchase the homes with a 30-year contract that includes a no interest mortgage. Their payments are \$500-600 a month. It provides the families stability for their kids and the kids can stay in school longer. They are in the process of building 16 new homes with 10 in Central Point. The goal is to help these families to break the cycle of poverty.

Habitat for Humanity has two Restores. One in Medford and the other in White City where surplus building supplies and other items a can be donated and sold at a good price.
